In an effort to commemorate Yom HaShoah together, they are partnering with the Holocaust Memorial Miami



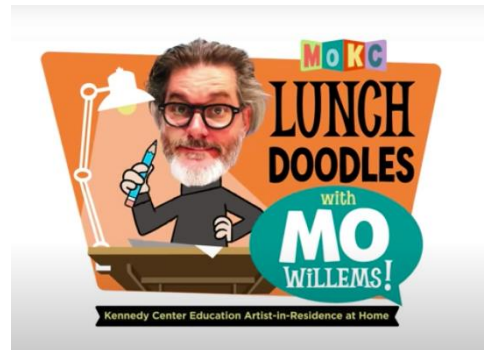
