Weekly Code Enforcement Efforts

Comments:

The Code Enforcement Unit issued one warning within the gated community this week. The warning was issued to a residential property which had a water meter being obstructed by landscaping. This was hindering Public Works from updating the property's meter.

Criminal Investigations

Comments:

The Criminal Investigation Division has developed new leads related to a theft at the Bal Harbour Shops, through investigative means, the detectives were able to identify the perpetrator and subsequently issued a countywide alert for his arrest.

Additionally, the Criminal Investigation Division conducted a follow-up investigation on a previous vehicle burglary, BHPD detectives collaborated with investigators from other neighboring police agencies who are investigating similar burglaries in their jurisdictions.

Comments:

The Bal Harbour marine unit responded to a boating incident several miles from the Haulover Beach shore line. After receiving numerous inaccurate coordinates, the marine officers were able to locate the disabled vessel and immediately summoned emergency personnel to treat the injured parties. One passenger sustained a severe leg injury when a passing vessels collided with the victims' boat. The marine officers immediately rendered aid until medical personnel arrived and transported the injured to an area hospital. Bal Harbour and Indian Creek marine officers canvassed the intracoastal waterways and located the vessel that crashed into the victim's vessel. The Florida Fish and Wildlife officers arrived and the operator of the boat was arrested for Boating Under the Influence of Alcohol and Leaving the Scene of an Accident.
